Regional Transition Navigator Services (RTNS) works with individuals aged 14-25 who have experienced or are at risk of experiencing severe mental illness, severe emotional disturbance or substance use disorder.

RTNS emphasizes working with individuals who are unhoused or at risk of becoming unhoused, who are aging out of foster care or juvenile detention, or who are at risk of human trafficking.
